DAEDALUS - ZABARAG - ST, JOHN'S

There are normally 4 dives a day (3 day dives + 1 night dive) apart from on your first and last day. There are around 19-21 dives on an average week but this can vary depending on local weather conditions.

Arrival

Once you have been picked up fromThis liveaboard safari explores the spectacular Southern Red Sea, taking divers to some of the region's most renowned reefs and marine parks. Begin your journey in Hurghada or Marsa Alam, then head offshore to dive iconic sites such as Abu Dabab, famous for its turtles and vibrant coral gardens. Continue to Daedalus Reef, a remote offshore marvel with dramatic walls, thriving coral, and the chance to encounter hammerhead sharks and other pelagic species. Next, explore the stunning reefs around St. John's and Zabargad, where pristine coral gardens and abundant marine life create unforgettable dives. The adventure continues to Sataya, Sha'ab Claude, and Abu Galawa Soraya, offering colorful reefscapes and thrilling drift dives. A night dive at Gota Bohar adds an extra touch of magic, revealing the Red Sea's nocturnal life. The journey concludes with dives at Elphinstone Reef and a final visit to Abu Dabab before returning to port. This route combines remote offshore reefs, exciting drift dives, and some of the Red Sea's most famous marine environments, making it a must for divers seeking variety, adventure, and spectacular underwater scenery. the airport you will be taken to the port to board your liveaboard. If you are making your own way to the harbour we ask that you not board before 16:00. There will be a full welcome briefing on arrival and you can set your kit up. If you have prepaid any rental equipment this will be given to you on arrival. Enjoy dinner on board and settle in. The boat will not leave harbour on this first night.


After the boat permissions are sorted, the boat will depart the next morning and the check dive will be made.
