

NORTH & STRAIT OF TIRAN

This tour takes you to the famous wrecks in the northern Red Sea, topped off with the fascinating reefs in the Strait of Tiran.

Wreck enthusiasts are sure to get their money's worth on this diving safari.

First, the tour heads to Shaab El Erg, followed by the wrecks of Abu Nuhas, including the Carnatic, Chrisoula K, and Ghiannis D.

The next wreck on the "menu" speaks for itself: the Thistlegorm, one of the most famous wrecks in the entire Red Sea.

This cargo ship, sunk in 1941, with its motorcycles, trucks, and a locomotive lying off to the side, captivates every diver who visits.

Diving then takes place in the Strait of Tiran at Jackson Reef, Thomas Reef, and Gordon Reef. If weather and current conditions allow, there may be an opportunity to dive the Rosalie Moller on the way back — a wreck that sank on the same night as the Thistlegorm and lies in the Gubal Strait.

After arriving in Hurghada, guests are transferred to the boat in Hurghada, followed by dinner and departure the next morning.

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Day 1 – Embarkation

Guests board the vessel in the evening (around 17:00–18:00), followed by a welcome briefing and cabin orientation

Day 2 – Check Dive & Abu Nuhas

Begin with a gentle check dive near Hurghada. Afternoon dive, and if conditions allow, a night dive at Abu Nuhas to explore wrecks such as Giannis D, Carnatic and Chrisoula K.

Days 3–6 – Gubal, Ras Mohamed & Strait of Tiran

Up to three day dives plus a possible night dive each day. Highlights include:

- Ras Mohamed National Park: Shark Reef, Yolanda, Anemone City.
- WWII wreck SS Thistlegorm, plus Shag Rock, Kingston and Gubal wrecks (Ulysses, Rosalie Moller).
- Strait of Tiran: Jackson Reef, Thomas Reef, Woodhouse Reef, Gordon Reef — spectacular walls, soft corals, drift dives, and pelagics.

Day 7 – Return North

Two relaxed morning dives near Hurghada, then cruise back to port by early afternoon.

Day 8 – Disembarkation

Guests disembark after breakfast, no later than 10:00.
